The Health Foundation Presents Early Bird Prizes for the \$100,000 Cash Lottery.

Individuals from 10 different communities share in the winning

Yorkton, June 3 – Theresa & Dennis Keyowski of Wishart received a cheque for \$5,000 for the first place prize in the Early Bird draw of The Health Foundation’s \$100,000 Cash Lottery. Tickets may be purchased for the \$100,000 grand prize until June 19th.

Ross Fisher, Executive Director of The Health Foundation, presented the cheque to the Keyowski’s, and to the other winners the other winners of the Early Bird draw. To date, a total of \$20,000 in prizes has been awarded in the \$100,000 Cash Lottery.

“This is the fifth year for The Health Foundation’s \$100,000 Cash Lottery, and tickets are selling really well this year; we have fewer than 600 tickets left,” said Mr. Fisher. “The lottery sold out last year and we have a good opportunity to sell-out again this year, so if people want a ticket they had better not wait”, he continued.

“Everyone knows that the monies raised by the lottery helps to buy medical equipment we really need in our health region; this year it will buy equipment for the therapies department for patients who are suffering the aftereffects of a heart attack or stroke. This is equipment we don’t have but we need, and that might be helping ticket sales” continued Mr. Fisher.

“People in the area know that regardless of whether or not they win a prize, we are all winners if we can buy this equipment,” he continued.

Tickets for the lottery are available at all Credit Union branches in the Sunrise Health region, as well as by phone and in person at the Health Foundation office.
